INSTRUCTIONS FOR TRANSRECTAL ULTRASOUND AND BIOPSY

Take antibiotics as instructed:

1. Take one pill in the morning **BEFORE** the procedure
2. Take one pill the night **BEFORE** the procedure
3. Take one pill the morning **OF** the procedure
4. Take one pill the night **OF** the procedure
5. Take one pill the morning **AFTER** the procedure
6. Take one pill the night **AFTER** the procedure
7. Use **Fleet enema** (green box) **2 hours prior to procedure**. Fleet enema can be purchased at any local pharmacy.

NO ASPIRIN, ASPIRIN PRODUCTS OR BLOOD THINNERS (i.e. COUMADIN, WARFARIN, PLAVIX) ARE TO BE USED 7 DAYS PRIOR TO PROCEDURE.
